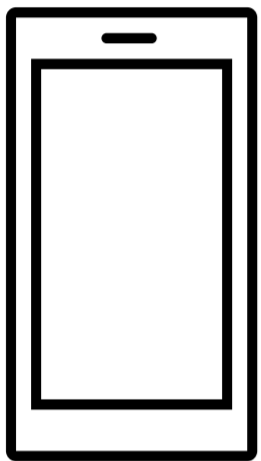




Heartburn Health
